- Create order set named "Joint Fluid Labs" with the following labs.
 - ✓ Cell Count w/Diff Body Fluid - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - Glucose Body Fluid - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - Protein Body Fluid - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - ✓ Body Fluid Crystals - Synovial Fluid, T;N, Routine
 - ✓ Culture Body Fluid - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - Fungal Culture - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - Acid Fast Bacilli Culture and Smear - Fluid, Unspecified, T;N, Routine
 - Pathology Non-Gyn Request (Cytology Body Fluid) - T;N, Routine
