• Cerner Order: IR Thoracentesis w/ US Guidance

For Providers

- Need to hold blood thinners: no
- Need to hold other meds: no
- Need to be NPO: no
- Need blood work: not routinely checked (if checked platelets $\ge 20k$ and INR ≤ 3.0)
- Receive moderate sedation: no (just local anesthetic)
- Routine pleural fluid labs:
 - Riverside, Southside, St Johns <u>cell count w/diff</u> body fluid, <u>LDH</u> body fluid, <u>glucose</u> body fluid, <u>protein</u> body fluid, body fluid <u>culture</u>, <u>cytology</u> body fluid
 - Clay <u>cell count w/diff</u> body fluid, <u>pH</u> body fluid, <u>albumin</u> body fluid, <u>LDH</u> body fluid, <u>glucose</u> body fluid, <u>protein</u> body fluid, <u>amylase</u> body fluid, <u>cholesterol</u> body fluid, body fluid <u>culture</u>, <u>fungal</u> culture, <u>AFB</u> culture, <u>cytology</u> body fluid

- Need imaging/radiologist review: no
- Need H&P: no

- Need an IV: no
- Need bed in Short Stay / PACU:

- Arrival time:
 - Riverside 1 hr prior to appointment
 - ➤ Southside, Clay & St Johns 2 hrs prior to appointment
- Stay after procedure: approximately 30 mins after procedure to allow for chest radiograph
- Rads that do procedure: Agrait (MA), Byra (BY), Carter (CA), Cohen (DC), Combs (JC), Edwards (JE), Hoffman (RH), Howard (JH), Jurasic (JU), Parsons (CP), Rezaei (AR), Roth (NR), Sherard (DS), Taylor (IT), Wood (CW)
- Order needs to specify side and specify diagnostic versus therapeutic thoracentesis.
- If for diagnostic thoracentesis, the order needs to specify what fluid labs are needed.
